52 mushers officially enter Iditarod XLVI on opening day

Wasilla, Alaska – Today, 33 mushers were on location at Iditarod Trail Committee Headquarters in Wasilla to officially enter the 2018 Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Race. Another 19 signed up by mail, rounding out the total to 52 mushers who submitted their applications on the first official entry day for the 46th running of the Iditarod.

Of the 52 opening day entries, nine registered as rookies. Nine teams hail from Canada, Norway, Czech Republic and Sweden, as well as three states outside of Alaska (Michigan, Montana, and New York) are represented.

Current and three-time champion Mitch Seavey; four-time champions Jeff King, Martin Buser and Dallas Seavey, along with a highly talented field of top finishers will undoubtedly make the 46th running of the Iditarod every bit as competitive as any race in history.

During the opening day festivities, the Iditarod also paid tribute to the hundreds of volunteers who were on hand by hosting its annual volunteer appreciation picnic. Race sponsor Golden Corral provided a catered lunch, and race sponsor Pen Air flew in fresh sockeye salmon from Bristol Bay.

Each year, two mushers are randomly drawn at the end of the volunteer appreciation picnic to receive a complimentary entry fee into the race. Veteran musher Joar Leifseth Ulsom of Willow, Alaska, and rookie musher Shaynee Traska of Two Rivers, Alaska, were this year's winners.

Mushers wishing to apply to enter Iditarod XLVI have until the close of business on Friday, Dec. 1, 2017, to turn in their entries. It is expected that the starting field will approach 80 teams.
