DALLAS SEAVEY FIRST INTO NOME - IDITAROD XLII CHAMPION

Nome, Alaska - Tuesday, March 11, 2014 – IDITAROD XLII Musher Dallas Seavey (Bib # 14) of Willow, Alaska arrived into Nome, Alaska and crossed under the burled arch at 04:04 a.m. with 7 dogs in his team, claiming his second Iditarod Championship in three(3) years. Thousands of fans lined the street to greet Dallas and his team on a brisk early morning in Nome.

Seavey's team traveled the Iditarod Trail in 8 days, 13 hours, 4 minutes, 19 seconds. Setting a new race.

Musher Aliy Zirkle (Bib #10) of Two Rivers, Alaska finished two minutes behind Dallas Seavey, with a total race time of 8 days 13 hours 6 minutes and 41 seconds.

Mushers on the Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Race will continue their trek to Nome and finish under the Burled Arch in the hours and in the days to come.
