- 1. Read the book or look at several pictures from the book <u>Dogs of the Iditarod</u> by Jeff Schultz.
- 2. Discuss how dogs have different traits and what they are. How are they the same, how are they different.
- 3. Pass out Activity Sheet and discuss how to fill out sheet.
- 4. Discuss the odds of each trait. (Ex. Are you more likely, equally likely, less likely for each trait)
- 5. Have students shake the dice to determine each trait for their dog.

6. Fill in the Trait Circle.
7. Have students look at other Trait Circles. Ask these questions:
Is there another dog just like yours?
Is there a dog exactly opposite of yours?
