6.	Mrs. Reiter (knowing how much her students like collecting patches) decides to buy each student in her homeroom a small patch. She gives the clerk three twenty dollar bills. How much change should she get?
7.	Mrs. Rizzuto decides it is really, really, cold in Alaska, so she treats herself to a sweatshirt. She gives the cashier a fifty dollar bill. How much change should she get?
