Lesson Summary: This will be an ongoing activity during the weeks of the Iditarod. Students will be acting as they are Jr. Insider crew providing the school with updates on the race. Students will use many modes of social media to share the updates.

- 4. Students will begin working on their Jr. Insider Job (see attached)
