Topic: Interactive Timeline **Grade Level:** Middle School

Lesson Summary: Students will be researching the history of Alaska and creating an online interactive timeline.

Learning objectives: Students will be able to classify events throughout the history of Alaska and arrange them in order on an interactive timeline.

Procedural Activities:

- 1. As a whole class: Ask students what do you know about the history of Alaska. Examples: who settled, who purchased, when became a state, what number, capital, etc. Write on the board.
- 2. Pass out *Alaska History Timeline Sheet* (see attached)
- 3. Groups: Explain directions to students
- 4. Students will begin researching information
- 5. When students are ready they will begin working on their timeline
- 6. Students will view another group's timeline
- 7. Students will complete *Alaska History Writing Assignment* (see attached)
- 8. Share writings and discuss
