

Norwegian Mushers

In the 2017 Iditarod there were four mushers from Norway: Joar Leifseth Ulsom, Ralph Johannessen, Lars Monsen, and Geir Idar Hjeltvik. Joar placed fourth this year, Ralph came in 16th place, Lars finished in 26th place, and Geir rounded out the group in 45th place. Another famous musher from Norway is Robert Sorlie, who won the Iditarod in 2003 and 2005. He was the first musher from overseas to win the Iditarod.
