Lesson Plan Title: Alaska's Gold Rush

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Discipline / Subject: US History

Topic: Gold rush in the Klondike and Alaska; analyzing primary and secondary sources

Grade Level: 6th- 12th

Resources / References / Materials Teacher Needs:

Lesson Summary:

Students will read secondary sources and primary sources on the Klondike and Alaska Gold Rush. From their study, they will create a Project Based Learning Task, an online page in a history textbook, discerning what to do with conflicting information, which primary source graphics to include, and what would best capture student interest in a text.

Learning objectives:

- 1. Students will understand the difficulties historians face when studying the pieces of history that primary sources provide and putting together "what happened" as best they can.
- 2. Students will analyze and coordinate information from various sources into a well-written on-line textbook page.

Assessment:

Procedural Activities

- 1. Introduce students to the quandary historians have when trying to piece together primary sources to determine what really happened during a historic event or time period.
- 2. Discuss primary and secondary sources, comparing and contrasting
- 3. Assign students the project task; it may be a group/partner project or individual project

4. Students use devices to read about the Klondike and Alaska gold rush, analyzing the various sources and then combining them into a product that will demonstrate their understanding of the event, as well as the challenge of combining information from various sources.

- Devices to view and read secondary source articles and primary sources

Modifications for special learners/ Enrichment Opportunities:

- 1. Students can research beyond the provided sites to gain more understanding of a particular event within the Klondike and Alaska Gold Rush
- 2. Students can arrange a Skype interview with a National Park Ranger in Alaska to possibly insert some video footage into their online textbook page
