

Pictograph Homework

The 2018 Iditarod mushers come from all over the world. Use the table below and create a pictograph that clearly reflects this data. Use the graph paper on the next page to make your graph. Then, use your pictograph to answer the questions on the page after the graph.

Mushers' Homes	Total
Alaska	49
Other USA	9
Other Countries	11
Total	69

Tips for Making a Pictograph:

1. Examine the data carefully and think about how you would like it to be displayed.
2. Give your pictograph a title. Make sure the title clearly tells the reader what the graph is about.
3. Decide on a picture or symbol to represent your data. The symbol should match the theme of the graph.
4. Determine an appropriate scale for your pictograph.
5. List your categories in a column on the left side of the graph.
6. Don't forget to make a key!
7. Double check that your data is recorded accurately!

Pictograph Questions:

1. What does the graph mean by "Other USA?"
2. What is the total number of musher running the Iditarod from the United States?
3. Are you surprised by the number of mushers from other countries? Why or why not?
4. What other countries might these mushers come from?
5. What is the total number of mushers racing in this year's race that do not live in Alaska?
