



**STEP 1:** Three circles. The head, the chest, and the hips.



**STEP 2:** Connect the circles with lines. Add additional basic shapes - triangles, curves, and a few more circles to create overall shape.



**STEP 3 :** Create more form and personality for your Alaskan Husky by shaping the eyes, nose, and fur markings. Draw lightly!



**STEP 4:** Begin to darken the details. Start filling out the shape - especially a little more weight to the neck and shoulders. Lines start to get a furry texture too, and you might erase just a little now from areas in the face and legs.



**STEP 5:** Start to darken the colored areas of fur. I started at the head and worked my way down the body.



**STEP 6:** The final darkening of the fur and maybe a little shading under the body or around the eyes and curving tail. Great job!
