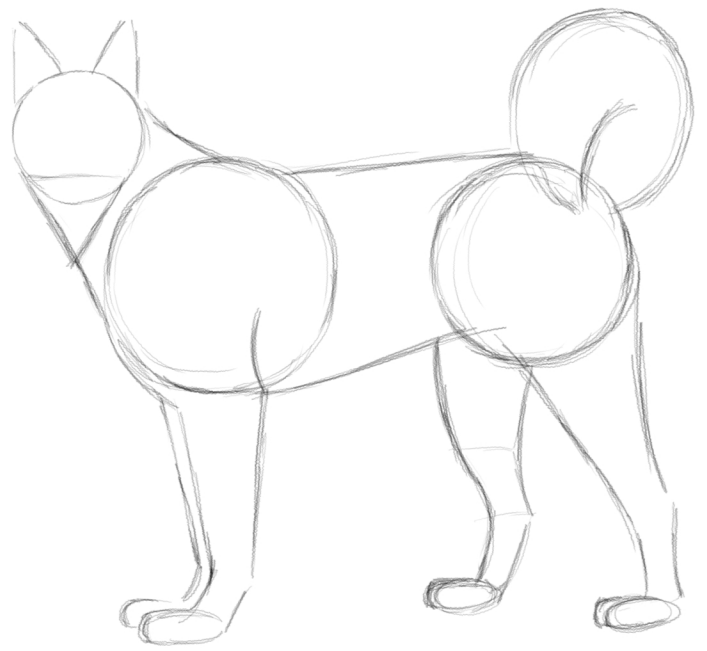
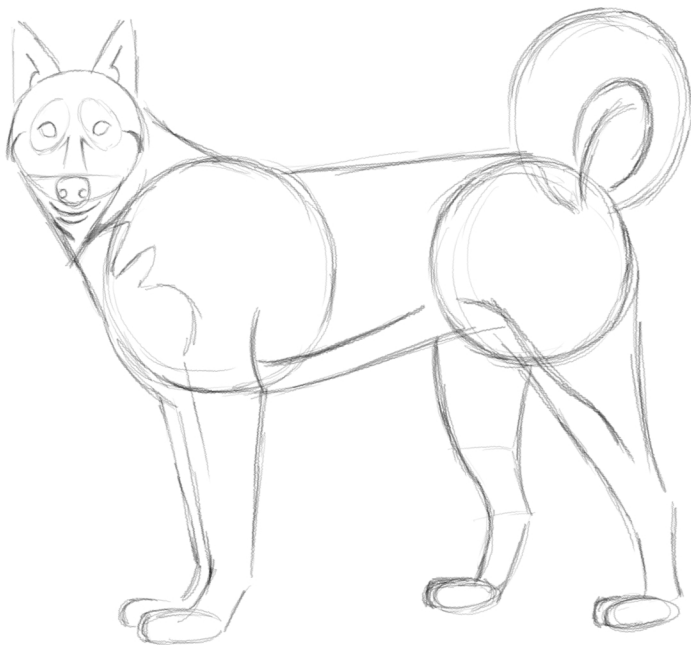


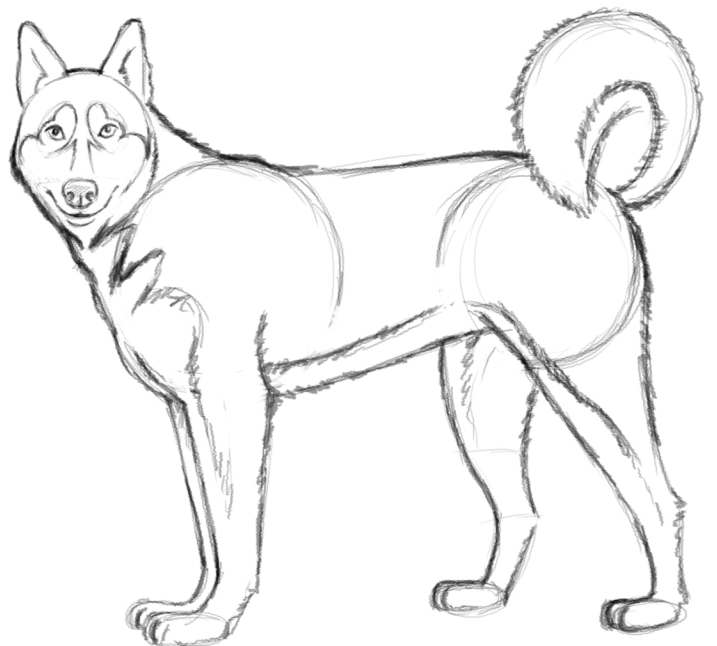
STEP 1 : Three circles. The head, the chest, and the hips.



STEP 2 : Connect the circles with lines. Add additional basic shapes - triangles, curves, and a few more circles to create overall shape.



STEP 3 : Create more form and personality for your Alaskan Husky by shaping the eyes, nose, and fur markings. Draw lightly!



STEP 4 : Begin to darken the details. Start filling out the shape - especially a little more weight to the neck and shoulders. Lines start to get a furry texture too, and you might erase just a little now from areas in the face and legs.



STEP 5 : Start to darken the colored areas of fur. I started at the head and worked my way down the body.



STEP 6 : The final darkening of the fur and maybe a little shading under the body or around the eyes and curving tail. Great job!
