Nicolas Petit first into Kaltag, wins Bristol Bay Native Corporation Fish First Award

Anchorage, Alaska – Veteran Iditarod XLVI musher Nicolas Petit (bib #46) of Girdwood, Alaska, is the first to reach the Kaltag checkpoint at 7:45 p.m. with 14 dogs in harness.

The award for the Bristol Bay Native Corporation Fish First Award includes a certificate for 25 pounds of fresh-caught, Bristol Bay salmon and a check for \$2,000.

The award will be presented at the Iditarod awards banquet in Nome, on Sunday, March 18. BBNC will also gift Petit a wood-burned art piece crafted by BBNC shareholder artist Apayo Moore.
