All such references shall be subject to review, and the reference must be available for candid consultation by race officials and the qualifying board before any final decision on acceptance is made. If the Iditarod qualifying board rejects an application, the applicant's entry fee, if paid, will be refunded in full. The rookie reference sheet must be received prior to consideration by the qualifying board of the rookie's application.
