

Sled Dog Snowflake, by Kate Newmyer, 2024 Iditarod Teacher on the Trail™

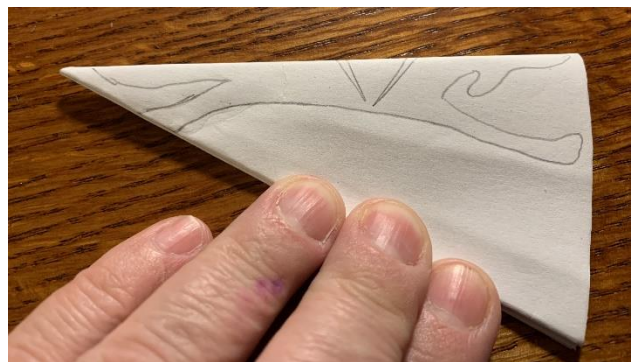
STEP 1

Start by making your printer page into a square and cut the extra part off. Then fold in half diagonally. From here, you will need to fold it into three equal pie pieces. Then fold the whole thing in half. This gives you six equal pie pieces. I always cut off all the uneven edges from the outer side at this point.

STEP 2

Here's my pattern. Note, the back leg is the piece that connects all the dogs into a snowflake. Make sure you don't cut around the bottom of the paw.



STEP 3

Cut carefully, using good scissors.

STEP 4

Unfold carefully.

Extra: If you would like to design a filler for between the dogs, or change the design, I'd love to see your ideas.
