Jessie Holmes, first to White Mountain, wins Northrim Bank Achieve More Award

Nome, Alaska – Veteran musher Jessie Holmes (bib #15), originally from Odenville, Alabama, was the first musher to reach the White Mountain checkpoint on Thursday, March 13 at 8:39 a.m.. with 11 dogs, earning him the Northrim Bank Achieve More Award.

Northrim Bank's award was first given out in 2018. Holmes will receive a \$2,500 check and a special trophy that resides at Iditarod headquarters year-round.

Our award continues to recognize the teamwork and dedication of the teams and their efforts to "Achieve More" during the race. As a homegrown bank deeply rooted in Alaska, we understand the resilience required to conquer both the challenges of the Last Frontier and the rugged Iditarod trail.
